Dear Ms. Frobos:

I am writing to inform you that the parties have tentatively agreed to attempt to have a hearing in the USADA and Floyd Landis matter held before a final arbitration of the Court of Arbitration for Sport. I have enclosed a letter confirming our efforts from Mr. Jacobs. Given this, the parties ask that you temporarily stop the AAA process including the selection of the chairperson in this matter until our efforts for a single CAS hearing are finalized.

While the parties intend to maintain their current arbitrator selection if the matter bypasses the AAA level and goes directly to CAS, the parties agree that their two arbitrator selections should have the opportunity to select the chair person from the entire CAS list as provided by the CAS rules and not just from the North American pool as provided under the AAA rules.

We hope to have this resolved in the very near future and will let you know as soon as we do.
